


Directions

- 1. Off-size and coated bulbs will be kept separate from recyclable crushed fluorescent bulbs.
- 2. Store off-size bulbs that are too large for Bulb eater chute and coated bulbs will be kept in marked **cardboard recycle container**.
- 3. Off size and coated bulbs will be kept separate from recyclable fluorescent bulbs. When cardboard recycle container is ¾ full, inform supervisor so that Heritage Crystal Clean can be contacted to arrange pick up. Bill of lading will be turned into Associate Director.
- 4. LED tubes that have a clear strip and/or label will be kept separate from recyclable crushed fluorescent bulbs.

5. LED bulbs are to be stored unbroken on the east side of the electrician's bench. Crescent Electric will pick up weekly.





Minimum Frequency

- CFL and Off-size Bulbs
 Container shall be inspected at least monthly; more often depending on usage.
- 2. CFL and Off-sized Bulbs
 Container shall be emptied at least **annually**; more often depending on usage
