



Illinois Wesleyan vs. North Park November 15, 2008 Wilder Field at IWU Stadium, Bloomington, Ill.

THE GAME: Illinois Wesleyan (5-4, 2-4 College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin) closes out its season at home against North Park (1-8, 0-6 CCIW) in a 1 p.m. game at Wilder Field at IWU Stadium in Bloomington.

SENIORS' DAY: IWU honors 15 seniors in their final game as an active Titan – Tom Almanzo, Cedric Bailey, Andrew Boyd, Martin Ceisel, Joe Duffy, Ben Hammer, Alex Holmberg, Josh Monk, John Nelson, Rick Podkowa, Dan Souder, Dewayne Stallings, Brian Tiefenbruck, Jerry Watkins and Christian Winston.

ON THE AIR: The IWU/North Park game will be broadcast live on WESN FM 88.1 and on the Internet at www.wjbc2.com and www.wesn.org.

CCIW IN THE POLLS: North Central is No. 3 (up from No. 4 after a win over Augustana) and Wheaton is No. 29 (up from No. 30) in the AFCA Division III poll (Nov. 11)...In the D3Football.com Top 25, North Central is No. 2 (third straight week) and Wheaton inexplicably fell to No. 32 (from No. 29). D3Football.com is a website devoted strictly to the coverage of NCAA Division III football, which releases a top 25 poll that's voted on by a panel of 25 coaches, sports information directors and media members from across the country...The Titans were No. 40 in the preseason D3football.com poll.

LAST WEEK: Illinois Wesleyan fell to 5-4 overall and 2-4 in the CCIW with a 44-10 loss at Wheaton on Nov. 8. The Titans managed only 235 yards of total offense while surrendering 448 to the Thunder. Trailing 7-0, IWU got on the board with 9:37 to play in the first quarter on a 37-yard field goal by Joe Duffy (Oak Lawn, Ill., Brother Rice HS) but did not score again until there was 5:54 to play in the game when, trailing 37-3, Brien Rooney (Western Springs, Ill., Fenwick HS) connected with Chris Messina (Chicago, Nazareth Academy) on a 14 yard touchdown pass. Dan Souder (Elk Grove Village, Ill., Elk Grove HS) had five solo tackles and assisted on 11 more to lead IWU defensively. Rooney rushed for 84 yards and threw for 54, going seven-for-16 with two interceptions. Kraig Ladd (Shelbyville, Ill., HS) was six-of-14 for 79 yards and Martin Ceisel (Deerfield, Ill. HS) made five catches for 51 yards.

IWU PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Chosen by Titan coaches to honor top players in the week's game and practices. The "Titan Award" honors a player for work ethic, loyalty and spirit.

KRAIG LADD: The junior southpaw is moving up the ranks of IWU career passing leaders. He is No. 4 in percentage (.573, 337 of 588), No. 5 in completions (337), No. 8 in yards (3,833) and No. 7 with 36 TD passes...He is No. 5 with 588 attempts and is also No. 8 with 3,878 total offense yards...His 21 TD passes this season is the sixth best in an IWU campaign...Ladd tied a school record with six touchdown passes in the 48-34 win over Alma Sept. 13. Ladd completed 17 of 26 passes for 272 yards in tying the TD passing efforts by Lon Erickson (North Park, 1995) and Brad Forsyth (Carroll, 1989).

MARTIN CEISEL: Senior Martin Ceisel (Deerfield, Ill. HS) is No. 3 all-time at IWU with 2,985 receiving yards (No. 2 is Eric White, 3,430, 2001-04), No. 3 with 29 receiving touchdowns and No. 4 with 200 receptions (No. 3 is Brady, 220).

JOE DUFFY: Senior kicker Joe Duffy (Oak Lawn, Ill., Brother Rice HS) was named to the second team of the Academic All-District V college football squad. Duffy has a 3.45 grade-point average as an accounting major. Only first team all-district choices are eligible for Academic All-America consideration.

COACH NORM EASH: Norm Eash (Illinois Wesleyan, 1975) is in his 22nd season at IWU and has a career record of 131-77-1 (.633), making him second among IWU coaches in victories (Eash's college coach, Don Larson, had 168 wins from 1954-86). Prior to 2006, Eash ranked 50th among all-time Division III coaches in winning percentage and 67th in victories (24th among active coaches in wins). The "dean" of league coaches, Eash has been College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin

"Coach of the Year" in 2007, 2001, 1996 and 1992. His career CCIW mark is 97-59-1 (.630), making him fourth all-time in victories in the league.

FOR THE RECORD: IWU is 83-48 in its last 131 games (.638) since 1995...The Titans are 73-30 (.703) at home and 58-47-1 on the road (.557) under Norm Eash...The 47 losses have come to Wheaton (8); Augustana (8); Millikin (6); North Central (6); Carthage (5); Elmhurst (3); Simpson, UW-Eau Claire, Mt. St. Joseph and Coe (2); and Mount Union, UW-LaCrosse, and Washington U. (1)... Last year IWU finished 7-3 overall and earned a share of the CCIW championship for the first time since 2001. It was IWU's 13th league title ... IWU's last three consecutive losing seasons before 2004-06 were 1941-43...In 2004, IWU (3-7) had its first sub-.500 season since 1993 (4-5). The Titans had been at .500 or better for 10 straight years.

NOVEMBER: In the Norm Eash coaching tenure, Wesleyan is 31-20 in November...IWU is 0-2 this year and the Titans were 1-1 in November in 2007.

ON TO THE NEXT 500: IWU is 516-385-42 (.571) in 116+ football seasons... The 500th win came in a 23-14 win over Wheaton on Oct. 22, 2005.

THE SERIES VS. THE VIKINGS: Dating back to 1960, IWU leads the series vs. North Park, 45-3. The Titans have won 22 in a row and 27 of the last 28, including a 20-14 win in Chicago on Oct. 27, 2007.

ABOUT THE VIKINGS: North Park junior Joe Cullotta earned CCIWi "Defensive Player of the Week" honors for his play in a 48-19 loss to Carthage at home on Nov. 8. Cullotta recorded 10 tackles, marking the second time in three games that Cullotta has recorded 10 or more tackles. He currently leads the team with 69 tackles (48 of which are unassisted)...North Park is 1-8 overall and 0-6 in the CCIW) after the Carthage loss. The Red Men went up 2-0 when they blocked a Viking punt that North Park covered in the end zone, then added a field goal to go ahead 5-0. The Vikings responded on the next possession, putting together a four-play, 69-yard drive that ended with junior quarterback Shelby Wood hitting junior Bill Ziemba on a two-yard toss to take the lead, 7-5. Carthage dominated the second quarter, however, scoring 29 unanswered points on three touchdowns and took a 34-7 lead at halftime. The Vikings took advantage of a Carthage fumble in the third quarter to close the gap to 34-13 on a one-yard completion from Wood to freshman Jeremy Dybdahl but NP's two-point attempt failed. Carthage increased its lead in the quarter on two successive TD drives that pushed the score to 48-13. Senior Jacob Mueller pushed his way into the end zone for a touchdown from the one-yard line to finish the scoring. Wood completed 24 of his 48

passes for 192 with two touchdowns. Mueller led the Viking ground game with 81 yards on 24 carries and a score.

IWU'S 2008 CCIW HONORS: Oct. 27: Junior QB Kraig Ladd and senior DB Robert Beauchamp were offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively. Ladd (Shebyville, Ill., HS) threw for four second half TDs to bring Wesleyan out of a 10-7 halftime deficit, leading the Titans to a win over Elmhurst. Ladd was 17-of-23 for 248 yards in the second half alone, and for the game, was 23-of-34 for 330 yards (the 14th best in an IWU game). Beauchamp (Cerro Gordo, Ill., HS) had 11 solos with one assist. He had a sack for -6 yards and made two other tackles for losses, totaling -6...**Sept. 6:** Senior kicker Joe Duffy (Oak Lawn, Ill., Brother Rice High School) was special teams player of the week for his play in 28-25 win at Hope. He had field goals of 39 and 36 yards. His 36-yard field goal came with 1:51 to play to stake IWU to a 28-19 lead and proved to be the margin of victory as Hope scored a minute later. Duffy also added two extra-point kicks.

UNDER THE LIGHTS: The Titans were 1-1 in night games in 2008 and played the latest night game on the calendar at home in at least 43 years (Oct. 25). In 2002 at night, IWU won its first overtime game in a 31-24 decision over Washington U. The Titans were to have played Aurora at night on Sept. 15, 2001, but the game was cancelled after the national tragedies of Sept. 11. Before 2002, the last home night game was Oct. 2, 1971, when Carthage downed the Titans, 22-19. Home night game results since 1965:

FAST START: The Titans were 3-0 for the first time since 2002 when they started with four straight wins (at Wis.-LaCrosse, 35-31; Washington U., 31-24 in OT; at Chicago, 34-16; North Park, 49-9).

CCIW VS. NON-CCIW: Teams from the CCIW were 19-5 in three weeks of nonconference play in 2008.

SEASON OPENERS: With the win at Hope on Sept. 6, IWU is 11-11 in opening-day games under Norm Eash. Prior to the 2008 win, the Titans had dropped their last five season openers, last winning in 2002 (35-31 at Wisconsin-LaCrosse).
