



## Illinois Wesleyan at Wheaton November 8, 2008 McCully Stadium, Wheaton, Ill.

**THE GAME:** Illinois Wesleyan (5-3, 2-3 College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin) travels to face No. 29-ranked Wheaton (6-2, 3-2 CCIW) in a 1 p.m. game at McCully Stadium in Wheaton.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** IWU will play its final game of the year at home vs. North Park at 1 p.m. on Nov. 15...It will be "Seniors' Day."

**ON THE AIR:** The IWU/Wheaton game will be broadcast live on WESN FM 88.1 and on the Internet at [www.wjbc2.com](http://www.wjbc2.com) and [www.wesn.org](http://www.wesn.org).

**THE SERIES VS. THE THUNDER:** Wheaton has a 27-24-2 lead over IWU in a series that dates back to 1922. The Titans earned an 18-14 win at home last season...Norm Eash is 7-13-1 vs. Wheaton.

**NOVEMBER:** In the Norm Eash coaching tenure, Wesleyan is 31-19 in November...IWU is 0-1 this year and the Titans were 1-1 in November in 2007.

**FOR THE RECORD:** IWU is 83-47 in its last 130 games (.638) since 1995...The Titans are 72-30 (.703) at home and 58-46-1 on the road (.557) under Norm Eash...The 47 losses have come to Wheaton (8); Augustana (8); Millikin (6); North Central (6); Carthage (5); Elmhurst (3); Simpson, UW-Eau Claire, Mt. St. Joseph and Coe (2); and Mount Union, UW-LaCrosse, and Washington U. (1)... Last year IWU finished 7-3 overall and earned a share of the CCIW championship for the first time since 2001. It was IWU's 13th league title ... IWU's last three consecutive losing seasons before 2004-06 were 1941-43...2004 and 2005 were the first back-to-back losing seasons since 1987 (4-5) and 1988 (4-5)...In 2004, IWU (3-7) had its first sub-.500 season since 1993 (4-5). The Titans had been at .500 or better for 10 straight years.

**ON TO THE NEXT 500:** IWU is 516-384-42 (.571) in 116+ football seasons... The 500th win came in a 23-14 win over Wheaton on Oct. 22, 2005.

**COACH NORM EASH:** Norm Eash (Illinois Wesleyan, 1975) is in his 22<sup>nd</sup> season at IWU and has a career record of 131-76-1 (.633), making him second among IWU coaches in victories (Eash's college coach, Don Larson, had 168 wins from 1954-86). Prior to 2006, Eash ranked 50th among all-time Division III coaches in winning percentage and 67th in victories (24th among active coaches in wins). The "dean" of league coaches, Eash has been College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin "Coach of the Year" in 2007, 2001, 1996 and 1992.

His career CCIW mark is 97-58-1 (.630), making him fourth all-time in victories in the league.

**LAST WEEK:** Illinois Wesleyan was guilty of three fumbles and four interceptions in a 30-7 loss at North Central on Nov. 1 in Naperville. The Titans amassed 294 yards to 281 for the nationally ranked Cardinals and had 254 passing yards in a game that saw all the scoring done in the first half. Junior Kraig Ladd (Shelbyville, Ill., HS) completed 25 of 40 for 240 yards and senior Martin Ceisel (Deerfield, Ill. HS) made eight catches for 103 yards. Ladd found Chris Messina (Chicago, Nazareth Academy) on an 18 yard pass with 1:46 to play in the first half for IWU's only touchdown. Nick Nikolich (Libertyville, Ill., HS) made seven total tackles and Max Brooks (Oak Park, Oak Park-River Forest HS) has six tackles and made a quarterback sack along with Ryan Jenkins (Richton Park, Ill., Rich South HS).

behind four second half touchdown passes from (Cerro Gordo, Ill., HS) led the IWU defense with 12 total tackles while Nick Nikolich (Libertyville, Ill., HS) had nine and Neal Loftus (LaGrange Park, Ill. Lyons Township HS) made seven tackles and had an interception.

**IWU PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:** *Chosen by Titan coaches to honor top players in the week's game and practices. The "Titan Award" honors a player for work ethic, loyalty and spirit.*

**KRAIG LADD:** The junior southpaw is moving up the ranks of IWU career passing leaders. He is No. 3 in percentage (.577, 331 of 573), No. 5 in completions (331), No. 8 in yards (3,7544) and No. 7 with 36 TD passes...He is also No. 10 with 3,798 total offense yards...Ladd tied a school record with six touchdown passes in the 48-34 win over Alma Sept. 13. Ladd completed 17 of 26 passes for 272

yards in tying the TD passing efforts by Lon Erickson (North Park, 1995) and Brad Forsyth (Carroll, 1989).

**MARTIN CEISEL:** Senior Martin Ceisel (Deerfield, Ill. HS) is No. 3 all-time at IWU with 2,934 receiving yards (No. 2 is Eric White, 3,430, 2001-04), No. 3 with 29 receiving touchdowns and No. 4 with 195 receptions (No. 3 is Brady, 220).

**ABOUT THE THUNDER:** Wheaton lost a 37-23 decision at Elmhurst last Saturday, its second straight loss and the first to Elmhurst since 1999. Wheaton took an early 3-0 lead when senior Tim Ellingsen booted a 23-yard field goal with 8:11 left in the first quarter. A pair of Elmhurst touchdowns in the second quarter gave the hosts a 16-3 lead. Wheaton cut the Bluejays' advantage to 16-9 when Thunder quarterback Sean Norris threw a three-yard touchdown pass to Danny Hindman with 1:35 left in the half, but missed the extra-point attempt as the Bluejays held a 16-9 edge at halftime. Elmhurst scored the only points of the third quarter to take a 23-9 edge and extended the lead early in the fourth to 30-9. Norris connected with Alex Pokorny on an 11-yard touchdown pass with 8:33 left in the game to cut the Bluejays' advantage to 30-16. Elmhurst extended its lead to 37-16 with 4:15 left before Wheaton's Rocky Gingg reached the end zone on a two-yard run with 1:39 left in the game for the final scoring. Wheaton had 310 yards of offense with 259 passing and a season-low 51 rushing. Elmhurst collected 391 yards of total offense. Norris completed 25 of his 47 passing attempts for 259 yards, with two TD tosses. Pokorny caught a game-high 10 receptions for 111 yards, with one touchdown. Gingg carried the ball 16 times for 49 yards, with one touchdown run. Stephen Pagh had 10 total tackles, including six solo, with a sack (-3 yards). Grant Roszkowiak was in on 10 total tackles, with a tackle for lost yardage (-1 yard). Reyes made nine total tackles. Tyler Langs made seven tackles, including six solos, with a 50-yard interception return. Ben Kuenzle made two tackles for lost yardage and Jon Ryan had an interception.

**CCIW IN THE POLLS:** North Central is No. 4 and Wheaton is No. 30 in the AFCA Division III poll (Nov. 4)...In the D3Football.com Top 25, North Central is No. 2 (second straight week) and Wheaton fell to No. 29 (from No. 15). D3Football.com is a website devoted strictly to the coverage of NCAA Division III football, which releases a top 25 poll that's voted on by a panel of 25 coaches, sports information directors and media members from across the country...The Titans were No. 40 in the preseason D3football.com poll.

**IWU'S 2008 CCIW HONORS:** **Oct. 27:** Junior QB Kraig Ladd and senior DB Robert Beauchamp were offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively. Ladd (Shebyville, Ill., HS) threw for four

second half TDs to four different receivers to bring Wesleyan out of a 10-7 halftime deficit, leading the Titans to a win over Elmhurst Oct. 25. Ladd was 17-of-23 for 248 yards in the second half alone, and for the game, was 23-of-34 for 330 yards (the 14th best in an Illinois Wesleyan game). Beauchamp (Cerro Gordo, Ill., HS) made 11 solo tackles and assisted on one in the win. He had a quarterback sack for -6 yards and made two other tackles for losses, totaling -6...**Sept. 6:** Senior kicker Joe Duffy (Oak Lawn, Ill., Brother Rice High School) was special teams player of the week for his play in 28-25 win at Hope. He had field goals of 39 and 36 yards. His 39-yard field goal came just 59 seconds into the game to give the Titans a 3-0 lead. His 36-yard field goal came with 1:51 to play to stake IWU to a 28-19 lead and proved to be the margin of victory as Hope scored a minute later. Duffy also added two extra-point kicks.

**UNDER THE LIGHTS:** The Titans were 1-1 in night games in 2008 and played the latest night game on the calendar at home in at least 43 years (Oct. 25). In 2002 at night, IWU won its first overtime game in a 31-24 decision over Washington U. The Titans were to have played Aurora at night on Sept. 15, 2001, but the game was cancelled after the national tragedies of Sept. 11. Before 2002, the last home night game was Oct. 2, 1971, when Carthage downed the Titans, 22-19. Home night game results since 1965:

**FAST START:** The Titans were 3-0 for the first time since 2002 when they started with four straight wins (at Wis.-LaCrosse, 35-31; Washington U., 31-24 in OT; at Chicago, 34-16; North Park, 49-9).

**CCIW VS. NON-CCIW:** Teams from the CCIW were 19-5 in three weeks of nonconference play in 2008.

**HOMECOMING:** After the loss to Carthage, the Titans are 28-16 in their last 44 Homecoming games and have been 10-11 in the last 21 years, preceded by a six-game winning streak from 1982-87.

**SEASON OPENERS:** With the win at Hope on Sept. 6, IWU is 11-11 in opening-day games under Norm Eash. Prior to last weekend, the Titans had dropped their last five season openers, last winning in 2002 (35-31 at Wisconsin-LaCrosse).
