

## Associate in Arts at Heartland Community College to Bachelor's Degree in Accounting at Illinois Wesleyan University

This plan does not cover the 150 hours needed for CPA exam. Student would still need to complete 22 additional hours. This can be achieved by registering for the maximum units at HCC and/or summer coursework. While additional coursework can be in any area, suggested topics include data science, data analytics, and technology.

- Students should meet with advisor about internship opportunities in the first semester of third year.
- At Heartland, choose a (G) Global Diversity and a (U) US Diversity course from recommended list to meet IWU graduation requirements.
- AP scores with 4 of higher, or higher level IB scores of 5 or higher, can be used to meet general education requirements at IWU, but not major or minor requirements.
- Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for the math requirement. However, remedial courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and hour requirements accordingly to complete degree.
- Completion of any 201 language course would complete the 2<sup>nd</sup> language requirement.
- Students should complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial or equivalent PE courses, at Heartland to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in a total of four years.
- Students are required, at minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level courses, and 18 courses and 18 units outside the major. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
