You may take those requirements at IWU and through the reverse transfer process, you will complete the requirements at Heartland. In choosing those courses, please work with your advisor to also complete the IWU Encountering Diversity requirement. Those requirements are detailed below.

## Notes

- Pre-medical Students: Pre-medical students are advised to take either HCC Introduction to Psychology (PSY 101) or IWU General Psychology (PSYC 100) before taking the Medical College Admissions Test. Similarly, Pre-medical students should take either HCC Sociology (SOC 101) or IWU Sociology.
- **COMM 101:** The COMM 101 course does not fulfill any IWU requirements. Students who plan to complete the GECC, plan to transfer IWU courses back to HCC for completion of the Associates Degree, or who plan to pursue the Pharm. D. degree after the bachelor's degree, should take COMM 101. (Pharmacy schools require a speech course.) Students who plan to complete the IWU General Education program may wish to opt out of COMM 101.
- Flexibility in Course Sequencing: Some students may feel more comfortable taking CHEM 161/162 and BIOL 161/162 in their first year at HCC and MATH 161/162 and CHEM 241/242 in their second year at HCC. This approach allows each semester to have a better balance between quantitative and conceptual STEM coursework. This is also a good arrangement for any student who takes pre-calculus mathematics before MATH 161.
- Foreign Language: Illinois Wesleyan requires students to complete a three-semester language sequence (101, 102, 201) or demonstrate commensurate proficiency. Students beginning language study at Heartland should be apprised of which languages can be continued at Illinois Wesleyan. Illinois Wesleyan offers 101-202 sequences in French, Spanish, Italian and Japanese. Illinois Wesleyan does not offer courses in Chinese or German. Completion of HCC GER 201, SPAN 201, FREN 201, ITAL 201, JAPN 201 would complete 2<sup>nd</sup> language requirement.
- Encountering Diversity requirements: When choosing courses to fulfill GECC courses at IWU, students should choose one G (Global Diversity) course and one U (Encountering U.S. Diversity) course to meet Encountering Diversity requirements.

- **AP and IB**: AP scores of 4 or higher and higher level IB scores of 5 or higher can be used to meet General Education requirements at IWU. If scores were used to meet major content requirements, equivalent hours within the major will be required.
- **Remedial Math**: Remedial math courses may be needed to prepare for MATH 161. However, remedial courses will not transfer to IWU. Adjust schedule and semester hour requirement accordingly to complete degree.

## **Ensuring Sufficient Coursework for Timely Graduation**:

- Students must complete a minimum of 64 semester hours, not including remedial courses or equivalent PE courses, at HCC to be on track to complete their bachelor's degree in 4 years.
- Students are required, at a minimum, to complete 16 units of coursework at IWU including half of all major requirements.
- Graduation requirements: 32 total courses and 32 total units with 9 courses and 9 units of upper level courses, and 18 courses and 18 units outside the major. (1 IWU unit = 4 semester hours)
